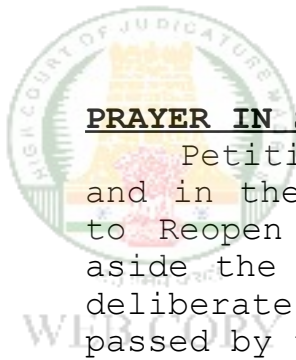

Prayer in WP(MD) . 20498/ 2016 :

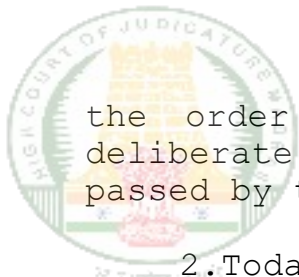
