2.Recording the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

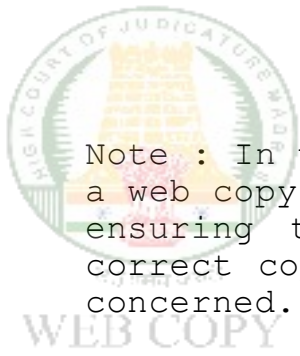
