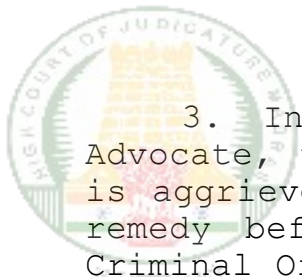

ORDER

This petition is filed to transfer the investigation in Crime No.144/2019 from the file of third respondent to the fourth respondent.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing on 09.11.2021, the learned Government Advocate submitted that based upon the complaint given by the defacto complainant, enquiry was undertaken and during the course of investigation, it was found to be mistake of fact. On that ground, final report was filed before the concerned Judicial Magistrate and RCS notice was also served on the defacto complainant, who is the petitioner herein. Since the matter is closed as mistake of fact, further action dropped.



3. In view of the submissions of the learned Government Advocate, this petition has become infructuous. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the contents of final report, he can work out his remedy before appropriate Court. With the above liberty, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
