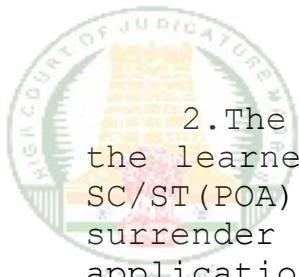

Prayer : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to direct the Special Court for Trial Cases registered under SC/ST(POA) Act, Dindigul, Dindigul District, to dispose the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of his surrender before the above mentioned concerned Court in pending investigation of Crime No.172 of 2021, on the file of the Inspector of Police, Sempatti Police Station, Dindigul District.

ORDER

The petitioner is the sole accused in Crime No.172 of 2021 on the file of the second respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 341, 324, 506(ii) of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.



2.The present petition filed by the petitioner is to direct the learned Judge, Special Court for Trial Cases registered under SC/ST(POA) Act, Dindigul, Dindigul District, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (crl.side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioner and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1)The petitioner should appear before the learned Judge, Special Court for Trial Cases registered under SC/ST(POA) Act, Dindigul, Dindigul District, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2)On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, concerned Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant and by complying with Section 15(5) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
