Prayer :Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to direct the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputhur (Special Court for exclusively triable of cases under SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act), to consider the bail petitions to be filed by the petitioners on the same day on their surrender in connection with Crime No.27 of 2021 on the file of the second respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioners are the accused Nos.1 and 2 in Crime No.27 of 2021 on the file of the second respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 379(NP) of IPC and Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2) (va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.



2.The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputhur (Special Court for exclusively triable of cases under SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act), to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

4.Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (crl.side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

5.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1)The petitioners should appear before the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputhur (Special Court for exclusively triable of cases under SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2)On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, concerned Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant and by complying with Section 15(5) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
