**ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed praying for a  
direction to the learned III Additional District Judge, Special  
Court for PCR Act Cases, Madurai, to accept the surrender of the  
petitioner and also to consider the bail application and pass orders  
on merits on the same day.



2.The petitioner is the second accused in Crime No.72 of 2021 on the file of the second respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 506(i) IPC and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.

3.Mr.R.Srinivasan, learned Government Advocate (criminal side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1)The petitioner shall appear before the learned III Additional District Judge, Special Court for PCR Act Cases, Madurai, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2)On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail application filed by the petitioner and pass orders on merits on the same day of his surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15-A of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
