PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. not known of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 506 (ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No. not known of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners herein said to have cheated the *de facto* complainant by creating false and bogus documents to his property and while questioning the same, they threatened the *de facto* complainant with dire consequences. Hence the complaint.
