PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.218 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is arrayed as accused no.2. He was arrested and remanded to Judicial Custody on 13.05.2021 for the offence punishable under section 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No.218 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

3.The case of the prosecution is that on 09.05.2021, based on the secrete information received from the respondent police, they intercepted the petitioner's vehicle transporting three unit of river sand. Hence the complaint.

4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

5.Heard the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police.



6.Considering the present pandemic situation, cash security is not ordered. But this order should not be taken as precedent. Considering the period of incarceration of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on the following conditions:

i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Lalgudi, Trichy District.

ii) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

iii) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police once in a week i.e on every Monday at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

iv) The petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness.

v) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

vi)On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[vii] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
