PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No 204/2020 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Section 379 IPC r/w Section 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals Development and Regulations Act in Crime No.204 of 2020, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 26.10.2020, at about 09.30 pm., when the defacto complainant and other party were involved in search, they found the petitioner illegally transported half unit of river sand by using Bolero Pickup bearing registration No.TN 55 AW 5208. The vehicle and sand were seized. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case.
