PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.166 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.1, who was arrested on 18.04.2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 417, 420, 465, 468 and 471 of IPC in Crime No.166 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent police.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and other accused forged 300 pattas and sold the same to various persons in Andipatti Village. Hence, the complaint.



4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and therefore, he seeks bail.

5. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, submitted that the the petitioner and other accused forged 300 pattas and sold the same to various persons in Andipatti Village. He further submitted that the petitioner was absconding for the past two years and also he has one previous case. Therefore, he opposes this petition.

6. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offences alleged to have been committed, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
