PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

To direct the Learned Special Judge (PCR) Trichy To consider the bail application of the Petitioners on the same day of the filling in Crime No. 150/2021 on the file of hte 2nd Respondent Police station on 30.04.2021,

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners are the accused in Crime No.150 of 2021 of Vathalai Police Station, Trichy District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324 of IPC and under Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned Special Judge (PCR), Trichy, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to also consider the bail applications on the same day.

3. Mr.S.Ravi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, who accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2, submits that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to consider the bail application on the same day of surrender, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1) The petitioners should appear before the learned Special Judge, Trichy within a period of one month, from the date of resumption of regular work in subordinate Courts in view of the present pandemic situation

2) On such surrender, the concerned Sessions Judge,



may consider the bail applications filed by the petitioners on merits, on the same day of their surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying with the Section 15(A) (5) of the said Act.
