Considering the submissions made by the learned counsels appearing on either side, the third respondent is directed to dispose of the petitioners' appeal dated 22.02.2021 and 11.02.2021 respectively, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order by giving the opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioners. The Writ Petitions are disposed of accordingly. No costs.

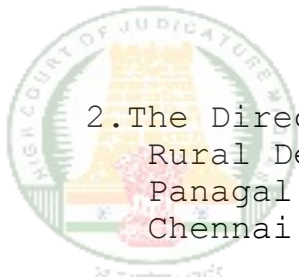
