PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.592 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Section 4(1)(g) r/w 4 (1) (A) of Tamilnadu Prohibition Act, in Crime No.592 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police and he seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in possession of 20 litres of alcohol soaking, which is used as a by-product for the preparation of illicit arrack.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner and he is nothing to do with the alleged offence.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent police, submitted that the entire prohibited substance has been seized and there is one previous case against the petitioner.



5. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent police.

6. Taking into consideration the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner on certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest by the respondent police on executing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.5,000/- [Rupees Five Thousand only] with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of the respondent police and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manapparai, and execute fresh personal bonds for a sum of Rs.5,000/- [Rupees Five Thousand only] with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of the concerned Judicial Magistrate, within a period of one month, from the date of resumption of regular work in subordinate Courts in view of the present pandemic situation and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bonds and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar cards or Bank pass Books to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police every Friday at 11.00 A.M., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**; and

[f] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
