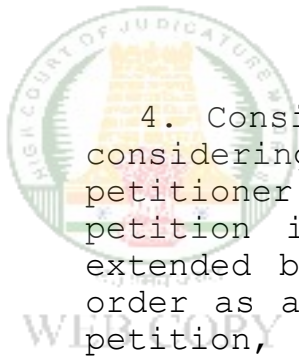

Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.C.SUSI KUMAR, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.M.MUTHUMANIKKAM, Government Advocate(Crl. Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the Court made the following order:-

The petition has been filed to extend the time granted by this court in Crl.O.P(MD)No.12231 of 2020 dated 03.11.2020, for producing the sureties and for executing the bail bond.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that due to ill health he is unable to arrange sureties and could not surrender before the concerned Magistrate and execute the bail bond within a stipulated time as ordered by this Court. Hence, he prays to grant further time to execute the sureties.

3. Heard the learned Government Advocate(Criminal Side) appearing for the State.



4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and also the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic situation this petition is allowed and the time for producing the sureties is extended by two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order as a last chance. Considering the long delay in filing this petition, the petitioner is directed to pay a sum of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) as cost to the **the credit of Government of Tamil Nadu, CMPRF in IOB**, Secretariat Branch, Chennai-9 (Account No.11720 10000 00070, IFSC Code: IOBA0001172) and produce the receipt/acknowledgment before the trial Court while executing sureties.
