On enquiry, the detenue would state that she married the petitioner in the year 2012, but they have no issues. It is further stated that due to matrimonial dispute, now she is residing with her aunt and she is not willing to go with the petitioner.

3.Recording the statement of the detenue, this habeas corpus petition is closed.

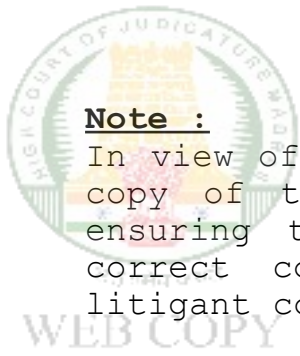
