Prayer in WP(MD). 6193/ 2019 :

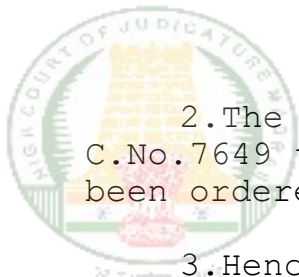
