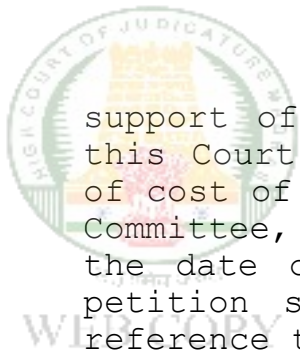
Prayer in CMA(MD) SR No.26461 of 2020:
