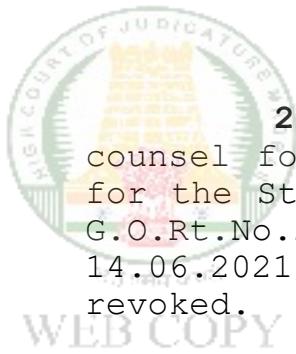

This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the wife of the detenu, namely, Arumugam, son of Antonyraj, aged about 22 years, challenging the Detention Order in No.22/BCDFGISSSV/2021, dated 16.4.2021, passed by the second respondent, branding him as "Bootlegger" as contemplated under Section 2(b) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Standing Counsel for the State appearing for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.2643, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIV) Department, dated 14.06.2021, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.

3. Recording the above submission, the habeas corpus petition is closed.
