PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.64 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

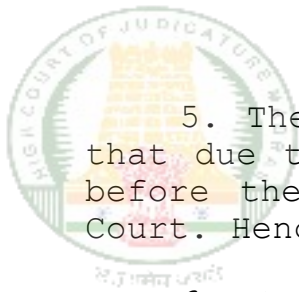
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/A-3 & A-4, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 341, 324 and 506(1) of IPC, in Crime No.64 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners scuffled with the defacto complainant and objected to give Electricity Service connection to him. Hence, the complaint.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police, on instructions submitted, that this is a second anticipatory bail petition and already anticipatory bail was granted to these petitioners by this Court on 05.05.2021 in Crl.OP(MD)



5. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that due to pandemic situation, these petitioners could not appear before the Court below, within the time limit prescribed by this Court. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail to these petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the submission on either side, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, these petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of surrender, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aravakurichi, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police, every Monday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**;

[f] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
