Prayer in Habeas Corpus Petition(MD) No.780/ 2020 :

Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court will be pleased to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, calling for the entire records, connected with the detention order of the Respondent No.2 in Cr.M.P.No.15/D.O/2020 dated 06.09.2020 and quash the same and direct the Respondents to produce the body or person of the detenu by name



Kuttai Murugan @ Murugan, S/o.Alagu, aged 38 years, now detained as "Drug Offender" at Madurai Central Prison before this Hon'ble Court and set him at liberty forthwith.
