PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.216 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Section 379 IPC and Section 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act in Crime No.216 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused said to have illegally taken three units of gravel sand from the Ayyur kanmai by using Ashok Leyland Tipper Lorry bearing Registration No.TN 78 D 2675. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.



4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent strongly opposed this petition on the ground that investigation in this case is pending.

5.Taking note of the fact that the petitioner along with other accused said to have illegally removed three units of gravel sand without any license from Ayyur kanmai and the fact that investigation is pending, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
