Prayer: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR Act Cases), Madurai to consider the bail application of the petitioner in Crime No.146 of 2021 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Sindupatty Police Station, Madurai District / second respondent herein and pass orders in accordance with law on the same day of his surrender if any petition is filed by petitioner.

ORDER

The petitioner is the sole Accused in Crime No.146 of 2021 of Sindupatty Police Station, Madurai District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of IPC r/w Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST [POA] Amendment Act, 2015.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioner is to direct the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR Act Cases), Madurai, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3. Mr.K.Sivabalan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-



facto complainant.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioner and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1) The petitioner should appear before the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR Act Cases), Madurai, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
