2.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the petitioner as well as the detenue appeared before this Court through video conferencing from the Public Prosecutor's Office. On enquiry, the



detenue would state that she has married the third respondent on 08.05.2021. Since the third respondent has applied for divorce from his first wife, she is willing to go with her mother Rajakani, who has also accepted the same.

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3. Recording the said statement, this habeas corpus petition is closed.
