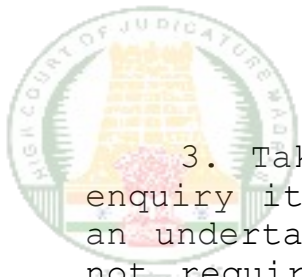

This Writ Petition is filed seeking for a direction to the second respondent not to interfere with the civil dispute, on the basis of the representation made by the petitioner dated 07.06.2021.

2. When the matter came up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.side) submitted that based upon the complaint given by the petitioner, enquiry was under taken in C.S.R.No.133 of 2021 and during the course of enquiry, it was found that it is a 'property dispute' between two brothers and they have agreed to settle the matter either before the Civil Court or before the elders in the village.
