PRAYER : Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, to direct the learned District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Sivagangai, to consider the petitioners bail application on the same day of their surrender in Crime No.150 of 2021 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Thiruppachethi Police Station, Sivagangai District.

ORDER

The petitioners are the Accused Nos. 2, 4 and 6 in Crime No.150 of 2021 on the file of Thiruppachethi Police Station,

Sivagangai District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 448, 294(b), 323, 336, 354 and 506(i) of IPC r/w Sections 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Act, 2015.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Sivagangai, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3. Mr.R.M.Anbunithi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl. Side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant and the respondents 4 to 6 are the victims.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioners should appear before the learned District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Sivagangai, within a period of 15 days, from the date of resumption of regular work in subordinate Courts; and
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

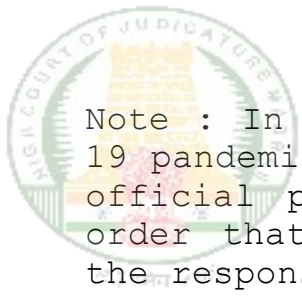
