PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.154 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.154 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, the petitioner has come forward with this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, it is represented by the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) that the case has been altered into Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST (POA) Act.



3. Anticipatory bail cannot be entertained for the offences committed under the SC/ST (POA) Act and therefore, this petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.
