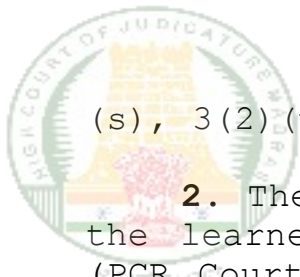
PRAYER : Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, to direct the IIIrd Additional District and Special Session Judge (PCR Court), Madurai to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day if its presentation on merits and in accordance with law with respect to Crime No.202 of 2021 on the file of the 2nd respondent.

O R D E R

The petitioners are the Accused Nos. 7 to 9 in Crime No.202 of 2021 on the file of Keelavalavu Police Station, Madurai District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 148, 294(B), 323, 324, 506(i) IPC r/w Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)



(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Act, 2015.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned IIIrd Additional District and Special Session Judge (PCR Court), Madurai, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3. Mr.R.M.Anbunithi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl. Side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioners should appear before the learned IIIrd Additional District and Special Session Judge (PCR Court), Madurai, within a period of 15 days, from the date of resumption of regular work in subordinate Courts; and
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
