PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.418 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/A1 and A2, who were arrested on 18.06.2021 for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(a)r/w. 4(1-A) of TNP Act in Crime No.418 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 18.05.2021 when the respondent police conducted vehicle check up near Thuvakudi toll gate, the found a four wheeler bearing Reg. No. TN 49 BR 5999. On seeing the police the occupants in the car tried to escape ,but the police apprehended one Rajkumar and on search they found a white color bag which contains 4 Nos Men's club brandy bottle each containing 375 ml, Royal accord brandy bottles 47 nos each containing 180 ml and VSOP brandy bottle 6 nos each containing 180ml, therefore the case came to be registered.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocents and they have been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the petitioners are in judicial custody from 18.06.2021, hence he seek bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police opposed this petition on the ground that the



investigation is not yet completed. He would further submit that no previous case is pending against the petitioners.

5. Taking into consideration all these facts and also considering the period of incarceration and also the fact that the material witnesses are only official witnesses and also the fact no previous case is pending against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Trichy and on further condition that

i) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

(ii) the petitioners are directed to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (**Rupees Ten Thousand only**) each to the Madras High Court Madurai Bench, Advocate Clerk's Welfare Association, Madurai-625 023 (Indian Bank Saving Account No.496039124, IFSC Code: IDIB000H040), without prejudice to their rights and contentions before the trial Court and produce the receipt/acknowledgment before the concerned Court while executing sureties.

iii) the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am., until further orders.

iv) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness.

v) the petitioners shall not abscond during trial.

vi) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

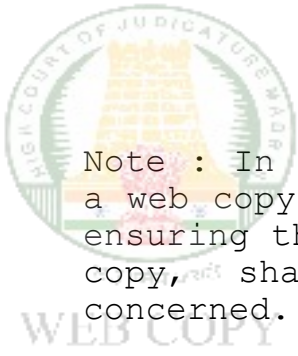
vii) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
