ORDER

The petitioners are the accused 1 and 2 in Crime No.353 of 2021 of Ambilikkai Police Station, Dindigul District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 294(b) and 323 of IPC r/w. Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners__and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1) The petitioners should appear before the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
