This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the mother of the detenu, namely, Sullan Karuppaiah @ Karuppaiah, son of Muniyandi, aged about 26 years, challenging the Detention Order in Cr.M.P.No.01/Goonda/2020, dated 09.01.2020, passed by the second respondent, branding him as "Goonda" as contemplated under Section 2 (f) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents and perused the materials available on record.



3.It is represented by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that in this case, the impugned detention order came to be passed on 09.01.2020 and the period of one year got expired on 09.01.2021 and therefore, the prayer sought for in this Habeas Corpus Petition has become infructuous.
