PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime no.425 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(1) of IPC in Crime No.425 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is working as security in High Tech Company at Thuvarangulam. On 24.06.2021, at about 09.40 pm, when he was working there, two persons came there to meet one employee Kalimuthu @ Chandru. The defacto complainant told them that he cannot let them in, as per the rules of the Company. Therefore, they scolded him in filthy language and entered into the company against his protest. After some time, both of them returned along with Kalimuthu @ Chandru. Kalimuthu @ Chandru also scolded the defacto complainant in filthy language and asked him why he did not let in his visitors and hit the defacto complainant with tiffin box on head. The other two persons also beat the defacto complainant and hit him with hands and

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he is falsely implicated in this case. Therefore, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Counsel for the Government of Tamil Nadu (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police opposed this petition on the ground that investigation is pending.

5. Considering the nature of the incident and the fact that injured had been treated as out patient, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur, Madurai on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

[a]the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b]the petitioner shall report before respondent police daily at 10.30 am., until further orders.

[c]the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f]If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
