ORDER

Since the same was not considered, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court seeking for appropriate directions.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 6.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a direction to the third respondent to act upon the representation made by the petitioner on 26.04.2021 and deal with the same strictly in accordance with the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, after affording an opportunity to the 7th respondent and final orders shall be passed within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
