3.The petitioner by way of this Public Interest Litigation, seeks for a direction upon the respondents to provide reservation to backward class Muslim at 5% instead of 3.5% for the people belonging to the Muslim religion in the state of Tamil Nadu.



4.The relief sought for cannot be granted in a proceedings under Article 226 of the constitution of India. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands dismissed. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
