PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.182 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under section 379 of I.P.C., r/w Section 21(4) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, in Crime No.182 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner had earlier moved this Court for anticipatory bail. Vide order dated 10.06.2020 in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.5878 of 2020, anticipatory bail was granted after recording the petitioner's undertaking that he would deposit a sum of Rs.7,500/- as non refundable deposit to the concerned District Mineral Foundation Trust.

4.The petitioner's counsel would state that due to certain reasons, earlier order could not be complied with. The petitioner is ready to abide by the undertaking earlier given. Two weeks time is given for depositing the said amount.



5. In view of the above, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvaiyaru, Thanjavur District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
