2. In the light of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

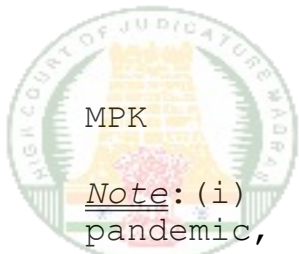
