PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.56 Of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/sole accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Section 379 of IPC r/w.Section 4(1)(1-A), 21(V) of Mines and Minerals Development and Regulation Act in Crime No.56 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 21.06.2021 at about 14.00 hrs they found the accused illegally removing sand from the Periyaodai and loaded it in a tractor bearing Reg.No.TN 58 AZ 5224 . On seeing the police the accused escaped from there. The trailer

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would also submit that no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police strongly opposed this petition on the ground that the vehicle and sand were seized on the spot and on seeing the search party headed by defacto complainant, the petitioner and other occupants escaped from the scene of crime.

5.This offence of illegal mining is not only an offence against any particular individual, but against the Society at large. It affects not only the present population, but the posterity as well. Investigation is in preliminary stage. In this view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
