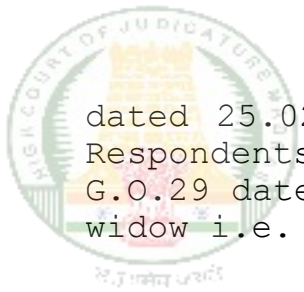

ORDER

Heard Mr. R.Saravanan, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. K.S.Selvaganesan, Learned Government Advocate for the Respondents and perused the materials on record, apart from the pleadings of the parties.

2. It is borne out from the record that the cause of action for the Writ Petition has wholly arisen and the seat of authority of the Respondents are situated outside the territorial limits of jurisdiction of the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court. Since the Writ Petition cannot be entertained in the Madurai Bench of this Court, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this Writ Petition with liberty to approach the jurisdictional High Court for necessary relief. He has also filed a memo dated 13.07.2021 to that effect through e-mail, which has been placed on record.

3. In the result, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn granting such liberty. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.

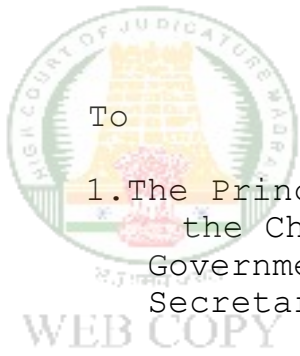
