Prayer in WP(MD) . 26209/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court Directing the respondents to pay 18 percent interest for the belated payment of terminal benefits of P.F, Gratuity, Unavailed Leave Salary and Commutation, payable to the petitioner from the date of his retirement i.e., 31.1.2019 to till the date of actual payment made to him and all other attendant benefits within the stipulated period.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 27324/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court directing the respondents to pay the service surrender leave salary amount of Rs.89,018/- payable to the petitioner for the period from 2009-2018 together with 18 percent interest from the date of his retirement i.e., 31.1.2019 to till the date of payment and all other attendant benefits to him within the stipulated period.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 26198/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court Directing the respondents to pay 18 percent interest for the belated payment of terminal benefits of P.F, Gratuity, Unavailed Leave Salary and Commutation, payable to the petitioner from the date of his retirement i.e., 31-05-2018 to till the date of actual payment made to him and all other attendant benefits within the stipulated period.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 25967/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court directing the respondent to pay 18 percent interest for the belated payment of terminal benefits of P.F.Gratuity, Commutation and Unavailed Leave Salary, Payable to the petiitonner from the date of his retirement ie., 31/05/2018 to till the date of actual payment made to him and all other attendant benefits
