The learned counsel submitted that none of the staff belonging to the Aided Educational Institutions have been allowed to participate in the election conducted by the second and third respondents. The learned counsel submitted that the Judgments passed by this Court in this regard has been strictly complied with and even in the nomination form, the order of this Court has been specifically mentioned.

3. Recording the submissions of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents 2 to 6, this Writ Petition stands closed. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
