Prayer in CRP(MD). 1246 of 2019 :

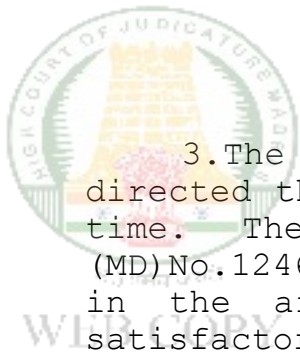
