2. The petitioners are the accused number not known in Crime No.2019 of 2020 on the file of the second respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 323, of I.P.C r/w 3 (2) (va) of SC/ST (POA) Act.

3. Mr.R.M.Anbunithi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He submits that no

- 1) The petitioners shall appear before the learned III Additional District and Sessions Court (PCR) Madurai within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
- 2) On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail application filed by the petitioners and pass orders on merits on the same day of their surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
