3.The learned Standing counsel appearing for the Madurai Corporation submitted that the representation given by the petitioner will be given due attention and necessary action will be taken in accordance with law, after notice to the second respondent.

4.In the light of the said submission, we dispose of the writ petition by directing the first respondent Corporation to take



appropriate action on merits and in accordance with law on the petitioner's representation, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
