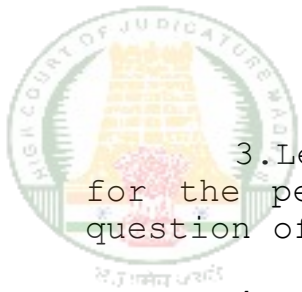

3.Let the closure report be circulated to the learned counsel for the petitioner. Since enquiry has been closed, there is no question of harassment at the instance of the private respondents.
