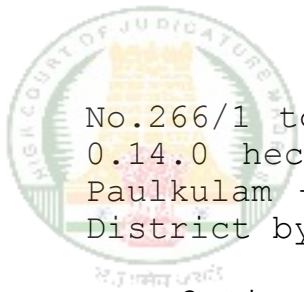

Heard Mr.M.Prabhu, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.A.K.Manikkam, learned Standing Counsel for Government appearing for the respondents 1 to 3.

2.The petitioner seeks for a direction upon the respondents 1 to 3 to remove the encroachment made by the 4th respondent in Survey



No.266/1 to an extent of 1.16.5 hectare and 266/5 to an extent of 0.14.0 hectare classified as Mayanam (Burial Ground) situated at Paulkulam - Maravamangalam Village, Kalaiyarkovil Taluk, Sivagangai District by considering his representation dated 06.07.2021.

3. Since we are disposing of the writ petition without notice to the fourth respondent, we are not inclined to issue any positive direction. However, the allegation being that there is an encroachment in a land classified as Mayanam, the third respondent is directed to look into the petitioner's representation dated 06.07.2021 and take action in accordance with law, after notice to the fourth respondent. This direction be complied with within a period of eight [8] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
