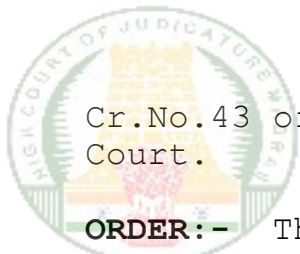

Prayer in CRL MP (MD) No.5061 of 2021 :-

Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is filed under section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, praying this Hon'ble Court to grant further extension of time to surrender Learned Sessions Judge, Special court for Trial cases registered under SC/ST (POA) Act Cases Dindigul and to comply the conditions imposed by this Hon'ble Court order dated 13.05.2021 made in Crl OP(MD) No.6673 of 2021 in Cr.No.43 of 2021 on the file of Inspector of Police, Vilampatti Police Station, Dindigul District.

Prayer in CRL OP (MD) No.6673 of 2021 :-

Criminal Original Petition is filed under section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, praying this Hon'ble Court to direct the Learned Sessions Judge, Special court for Trial cases registered under SC/ST (POA) Act Cases, Dindigul to consider the bail application to be filed by the petitioner on the same day in

This petition has been filed to extend the time to surrender before the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for Trial Cases registered under SC/ST (POA) Act Cases, Dindigul, as per the order of this Court dated 13.05.2021 made in Crl.O.P(MD).No.6673 of 2021.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that by order dated 13.05.2021, the petitioner was ordered to surrender before the concerned Court within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order/uploading this order.
