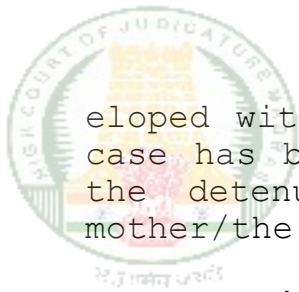
O R D E R

The Petitioner has come forward with this Habeas Corpus Petition seeking for a direction to the respondents 1 and 2 to produce the Petitioner's daughter Manjula, aged about 17 years (Minor), before this Court and hand over the custody to the Petitioner.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials placed before this Court.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the detenu was produced by the second respondent through video-conferencing from the Public Prosecutor's Office. It is represented by the learned Standing Counsel for the State that the detenu had



eloped with the third respondent and after securing the detainee, a case has been registered against the third respondent. On enquiry, the detainee would state that she is willing to go with her mother/the Petitioner herein.

4. In the light of the above statement made by the detainee, this Court is of the view that no further adjudication is required in this Habeas Corpus Petition and accordingly, the same stands closed.
