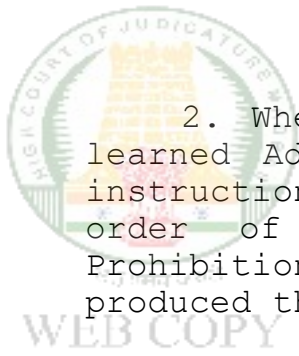
PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, calling for the records pertaining to the impugned detention order passed by the second respondent made in his proceedings in P.D.No.81/2021, dated 15.07.2021, in detaining the detenu under Section 2 (e) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 as a Drug Offender and quash the same and direct the respondents to produce the detenu namely Mangalam W/o.Selvarasu, female, aged about 50 years, who is detained in Special Prison for Women, Tiruchirappalli, before this Court and set him at liberty.
