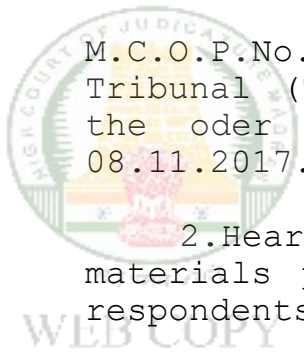
Prayer in CMA(MD) . 629/ 2017 :
