Prayer in CRL A(MD).No.43 of 2021 :

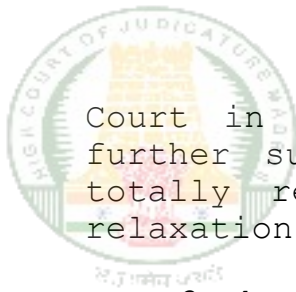
