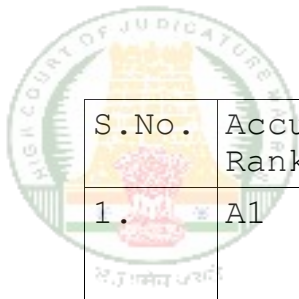
PRAYER :-
